

PROMISING PLACES

Because they belong to the same district, all Chicago grade schools report the same district-wide number for spending per student and for pupil-teacher ratio-which meant we couldn't use the same ranking system in the city as we did in the counties. Instead, on the chart above, we ranked Chicago schools based only on performance on standardized tests. Below, however, we identified schools that performed well on tests and had smaller class sizes-two measures that make a good combination.
